Inspector General of Police

The Inspector General of Police or IGP is the senior most police officer in the Pakistan Police force. The office was established on 8 March 1947, as a result of the separation of the civil and military wings of the police force. The first IGP was Anwar Shah Kashmiri.

Functions and Responsibilities

The IGP has the following functions: The IGP reports to the Federal Law and Justice Division (LJD), under the Ministry of Interior. The Inspector General of Police (IGP) is a chief in the Pakistan Police and the Director General of the Punjab Police are the senior most in the Pakistan Police. The Inspector General of Police is an appointed official, who is also an IGP is one of the three senior officials who advises the president on matters concerning the police and prisons. The IGP is the head of the National Police Commission (NPPC). The IGP chairs the meetings of the NPPC, and makes recommendations to the President of Pakistan concerning the implementation of the NPPC. The NPPC, which is responsible for formation of the police, is made up of the Police Commissioner, the Inspector General of Police, the Federal Secretary Interior, the Chief of Army Staff, the Chief of Navy and the Chief of Air-force, along with the Auditor General and the Federal Minister for Home Affairs. A Chief Inspector General of Police or CIGP is responsible for the investigation of any acts of corruption within the police force. CIGPs are appointed by the IGP. A Commissioner of Police or CCP is responsible for maintaining the law and order in his or her area. CCPs report to the Commissioner of Police in their district, but are supervised by the IGP and his office. The IGP is appointed by the President of Pakistan, and is in charge of all the provincial police departments.
